

MULLIGAN 2

QUICK START GUIDE

Welcome to Mulligan 2, the next evolution of hands-on MIDI control for Pro Tools™.

Ideally, this quick start guide would consist of a single line:

Launch Mulligan 2 and follow the Setup Wizard.

However, here are a few more details that might be helpful:

- Mulligan 2 uses the HUI protocol to communicate with Pro Tools. This has allowed us to add **many more mappable commands** that were previously not available in Mulligan 1.
- In order to be able to control plugins with Mulligan 2, you must set it up in **MIDI controller slot #1** (don't worry, the Setup Wizard will walk you through the details).
- If you already have a HUI controller that you want to keep in slot #1, fear not. Mulligan 2 includes a **HUI Device Forwarding** feature that allows it to share slot #1 with another device. To enable this, select HUI > HUI Device Forwarding, and then use HUI > HUI Device Input and HUI > HUI Device Output to choose the ports for your other HUI controller. When using this forwarding, your other controller no longer connects directly to Pro Tools — instead, it gets routed through Mulligan — therefore the other controller no longer needs to be configured in the Pro Tools Setup > Peripherals > MIDI Controllers dialog.
- One big change in Mulligan 2 is that **plugins must now include a resource called a page table file to be compatible for plugin control**. While many plugins already include this file, some do not. You can choose Window > Plugin Compatibility Report to view which of your plugins will work with Mulligan 2. Please see [this FAQ](#) for more details on plugin compatibility.
- **Selected Plugin and Current Track:** Plugin and track selection are now independent of each other. You can click a **plugin** on any track to make it the focused plugin for Mulligan control. To select a **track** for Mulligan control, you can click on it if it's within the blue-outlined bank of 8 HUI tracks, or map Mulligan's Track Navigation commands to select tracks and banks with your MIDI controller. With the Pro Tools Preference "*Scroll To Track*" *Banks Controllers* option checked, you can also *Control-Shift-click* on a track, to jump HUI bank selection to that track.
- **Note to Mulligan 1 users:** Using Mulligan 2 will not overwrite your existing Mulligan 1 settings — user data for the two versions is saved separately. While you can keep both apps installed on your system, you cannot run them both at the same time.
